### **Roses Fundraiser**

It was a great success and everyone was so pleased with the plants. In fact, buyers are asking for more! Your singer will be bringing a packet of information home regarding the sale of these roses. We are asking each family to sell a minimum of 5 rose bushes – or – donate the sales profit to the Chorus. This is our major fundraiser for the fall and it is very important that each family participate in some way. We sell the roses for \$18 each and the Chorus profit is \$13. This fundraiser is unique and the quality of the item is exceptional, so please support this project. Proceeds from this sale will benefit the Chorus program and all singers. The sale starts on Monday, October 1 and roses will be available for pick-up at Community Ed on Friday, October 26 from 4 – 6 pm. All orders are due in the Chorus office by Monday, October 23.
